- 5. Write an essay on the purpose of the study, indicating the specific reasons why he or she would like to enroll in UA&P MA in Child Development or MA in Educational Leadership, how the program fits his or her professional development needs and plans; what he or she foresees as difficulties or obstacles he or she will meet, and how he or she plans to overcome them and what he or she intends to do after having completed the program.
- 6. Submit recommendation forms (one from School Head and from another person (a university or college professor, a former employer, or someone of reputable standing in his or her profession) who can make a fair and objective assessment of the applicant's ability to pursue graduate studies in Education.
